Imagine This ~ By Bob Philo Board Of Governors President

Jayson and I met recently to go over our Club's financial reports. The bottom lines are that our Club's financial health (like most clubs) depends on membership dues and the most significant dues factor is the number of full privilege golf memberships. The accompanying chart reflects the number of golf memberships over the past several years. As you can see, the downturn in the economy had a significant negative effect.

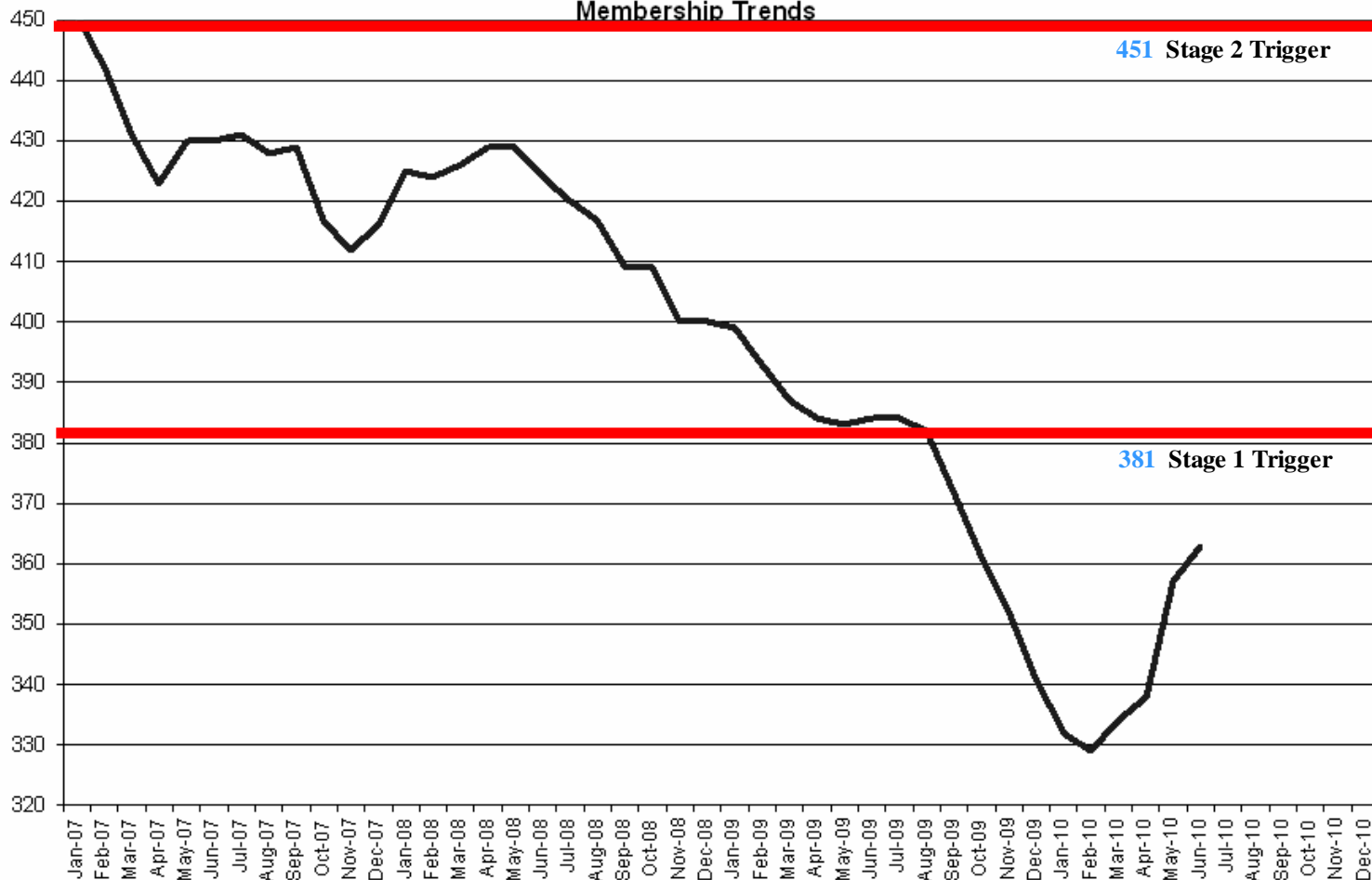
For a long time, we experienced more resignations and downgrades than we recruited new golf members. But that trend has reversed recently and we are now gaining back more new members than we are losing each month. Every club experiences a turnover in members – natural attrition. Every club must continue to recruit new members to replace those that are lost.

The good news is that we have turned the corner. Today, we are only 17 net new golf members away from our Stage 1 target for release of the accumulated Wish Funds. By the time you read this we will be even closer. When we get to Stage 1, we will be able to spend \$2,000 for each net new member on member-selected capital improvements. \$1,500 of that will come from the funds we have accumulated and \$500 will be added by our owners. As we grow towards Stage 2 (see chart) we will have approximately \$120,000 to spend. At Stage 2, we get even more dollars for each net new member. When we get to Full-With-A-Waiting-List, we will have earned and spent more than one half million dollars on new member-selected improvements.

So, our club is recovering from the effects of the bad economy, is generating a small operating profit and our prospects for the future are good. The past two years have been frustrating for our management team, for your Board of Governors and for most of our members. There have been projects that we wanted to do, ideas that we wanted to implement and items that we had to cut back or eliminate. But those days will soon be over as long as we continue to gain full privilege members. Keep those referrals coming and start thinking about how you want us to spend those Wish Fund dollars.

It's that time of year again!

It's that time of year again where I have to gently remind everyone about the most often bent/forgotten/ignored club policies and rules. I don't want to sound too harsh but there are some things that I have seen a lot of lately, and just want to make sure everyone is on the same page about them.

Cart traffic – The majority of the time, we allow you to take the carts off the paths. We only ask that you return them to the paths around tees, greens, and certain areas that we are trying to keep traffic off of. Please be mindful of that, and avoid driving up next to the tee boxes, around the back side of greens, etc... you know where you are not supposed to drive. Also, when we are restricted to the path, please observe this. Too often I see carts staying on the paths only on the holes next to the club house, and when they get out of sight, off the path they go. Also, carts must stay on property. Please do not take them into the neighborhood, or on the streets.

Guest policy – A person is allowed to play as a guest at Eldorado once per quarter. For those guests that are in from out of town, (family, etc...) the golf staff can waive that rule with prior consideration. One of the benefits of membership is our attractive guest pricing. To maintain the ability to do that, we ask that no one guest takes advantage of that benefit by playing more than once a quarter. We have this policy in place to protect the value of your membership.

Dress Code – Please remember that our dress code applies to all areas of the golf facility. That includes the course, the practice range, and the putting green. Proper golf attire is required at all times.

Practice Range – The practice range is a valuable amenity for our golfing members only. Unfortunately, we don't have a practice plan available for our other categories of memberships at this time. We ask that players wanting to practice do so in the areas that we have set out for you to practice on. Please stay on the mats when we are set up on the mats; please practice in the designated practice area. We have an area that we have designated for teaching and ask that players refrain from hitting balls in this area, even if there are no lessons taking place.

These guidelines are set forth by your board of governors, and they are set forth so that everyone can enjoy the use of the club. It's a little uncomfortable for a staff member to have to come out and point out to someone that they are not following the rules. So please help us out and be especially mindful of these that are most often abused.

Fitness and Nutrition Tips

Core Muscles – Strong or Weak?

What are your core muscles? In general, the muscles of the core run the length of the trunk and torso; and when contracted, stabilize the spine, pelvis, and shoulder girdle. The goal of core stability is to maintain a solid foundation and transfer energy from the center of the body out to the limbs. *This is paramount for both golf and tennis players.* Muscles that accomplish this goal include: rectus abdominis; erector spinae; multifidus; external obliques; internal obliques; transverse abdominis; hip flexors; as well as the gluteus maximus, medius, and minimus. (Note: secondary muscles groups may be included by different experts, but the above are the primary muscles groups of the core.)

Three reasons to strengthen your core:

- Improve balance and stability
- Ease in performing physical and functional activities
- Prevent injury

Exercises to strengthen your core include: plank, yoga boat pose, and superman. To ensure proper form when performing core exercises, contact one of the fitness professionals at the Eldorado Country Club for further information & assistance.

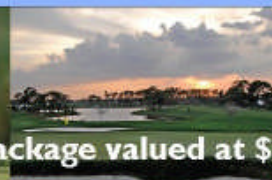
