What does your Board of Governors really do? The Board acts as liaison between APGM (Arnold Palmer Golf Management) and the Members. While APGM has dominion over all matters affecting its investment in ECC, it empowers the Board to represent the Membership. The Board weighs the advisability of measures calculated to maximize satisfaction by the majority of Members consistent with the goals of ownership. The Board recommends appropriate actions to APGM through the General Manager.

How is this accomplished? Through the creation of committees and delegation of authority to those committees. By participation in as many club activities as possible. By leading by example. By working with the Management to help plan and prioritize capital improvement projects throughout the Club property. By having two objectives in mind: the quality of the Club's services for all members; and, the continued growth of the membership thus insuring the financial future of the Club.

Members of the Board consist of representatives from the MGA, SMGA, EWGA, ENGA, a tennis representative, the Ambassador Club Chair and six at large members to represent the general membership. Generally speaking, the President of each recognized organization serves as the representative of that organization during his or her term. No term can be longer than 2 years except the term of an at large member elected to be President of the Board in his or her second year of service. The President and all at large Members serve 2 year terms. Three new at large members are elected by the general membership each December.

So, if you are unhappy about some Club policy contact your Board Member(s) and let them know so they can bring it to the next monthly meeting for consideration. But if you are unhappy about some enforcement of policy or provided service, or lack thereof, bring it to the attention of our Manager or staff person so that it can be dealt with immediately. Your Board does not enforce the rules, we advise Management as to what they should be.

Remember that we will be electing 3 new at large Board members in December. Would you like to serve your Club in that capacity?

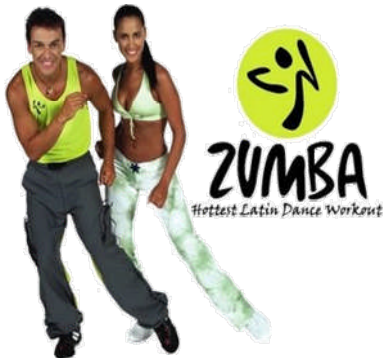

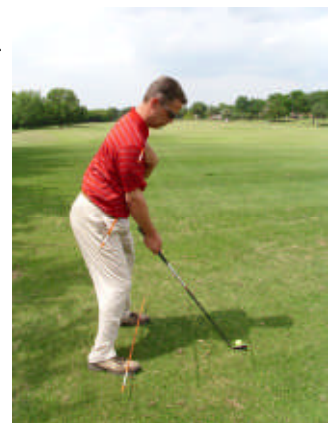

Golf Tip of the Month

Have your tires ever been out of alignment? You have to fight the steering wheel in order to keep the car going straight. So you need to keep your car's wheels in alignment in order for it to operate efficiently. Did you know we need to do the same with our golf swing? The four tires that you need aligned in your golf swing are the following: Your feet, your hips, your shoulders, and your eye line. If they are not in alignment, you will have to fight the steering wheel in order for it to go straight. If you look at the first picture, you will see that my tires (feet, hips, shoulders, and eyes) are all pointing different directions. If you look at the second picture, you will see that my tires are all now aligned. It will be much easier to make a good, more repeatable swing. If you think your tires are out of alignment (in your swing that is) then make an appointment to see your favorite swing mechanic. We can get you straightened up.
