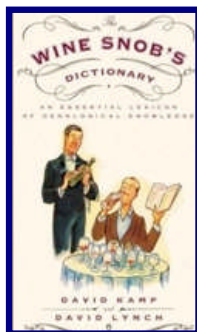

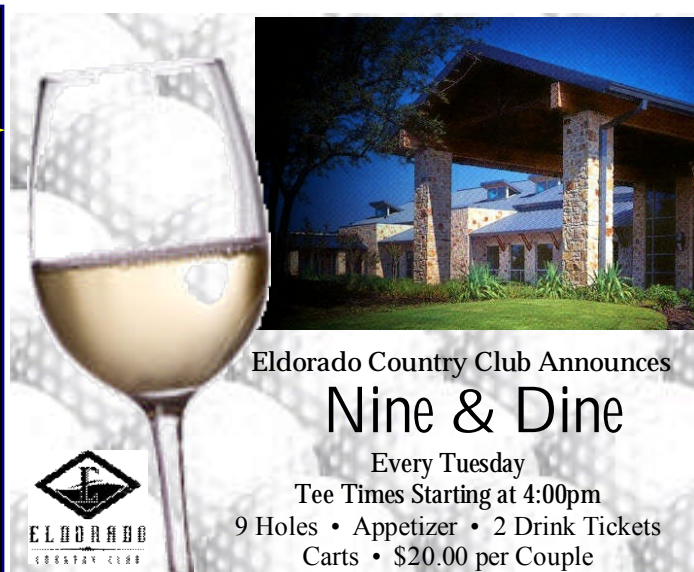

Juni or Golf Program

Eldorado Fall/Winter Junior Golf Program

Goal: To provide a year round program for students to improve their skills in the game of golf; to make the instruction fun; to establish and help students reach their golf goals; to keep student/teacher ratios at 8:1 to provide the best learning environment.

Program Outline:

Developmental Tour Level – Introduction of basic skills and knowledge of the game of golf. Students do not need any previous golf experience. Students will leave the program able to hit basic golf shots/make putts, and know the basic rules/etiquette of golf.

Mini-Tour Level – Geared to expand on Developmental Tour skills to include more detailed full swing and short game techniques. Students will need to have successfully completed the Developmental Tour Level skills test or have shot a 9-hole score of 60 or less from at least the Gold Family Tees. Students will leave this level of the program with enough skill and knowledge of rules to participate in entry level junior golf tournaments.

PGA/LPGA Tour Level – Most advanced level of instruction to include course management, mental skills, trouble shots, and tournament preparation. Students will need to have successfully completed the Mini-Tour Level skills test or have shot a 9-hole score of 45 or less from the forward tees. Students will leave this level with enough skill and knowledge of rules to be able to try out for respective golf teams and/or play in advanced junior level tournaments.

Developmental Tour – First and Third Saturdays of the month (unless club event is scheduled) 10:00am – 11:00am.

Mini-Tour – First and Third Saturdays of the month (unless club event is scheduled) 9:00am – 10:00am.

PGA Tour – Second and Fourth Saturday of the month (unless club event is scheduled) 10:00am – 11:00am.
