Message From The Manager ~ By Jayson Petersen General Manager



I have been asked to write an article for this month's newsletter explaining the purpose of the service charge we bill. Those of you who have been around a while have seen the club's policy regarding food and beverage service charge change over the years and for those of you who are newer members may not necessarily understand what you are being billed for. In most private clubs you are charged 18-20% service charge on everything you buy from the food and beverage department automatically at the point of sale. From a candy bar to cheeseburger everything has an automatic percentage added on. Here at Eldorado we have converted to a flat service charge of \$22 per month in lieu of the percentage. Whether a club charges 18-20% or the flat monthly service charge all clubs primarily use this money to compensate their service staff. This service charge allows us to pay our servers more than the typical \$2-3 per hour that wait

staff make at a standard cash house type restaurant. Our servers make between \$7.25 and \$12 per hour depending on tenure with the club. Tipping above and beyond the service charge is totally optional and up to you at the time of service. Some of our members have requested to have the option of adding an additional tip to their bill thus the reason for the added tip line. Any additional tip added to your check will go directly to that employee and is not pooled amongst the entire staff. I hope this has answered any questions you may have and if not feel free to call me at the club any time.

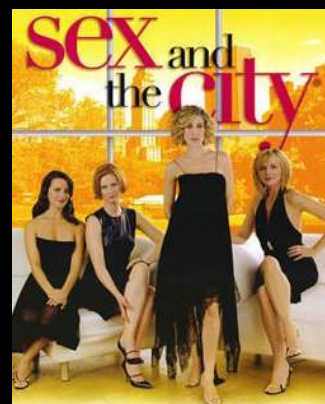

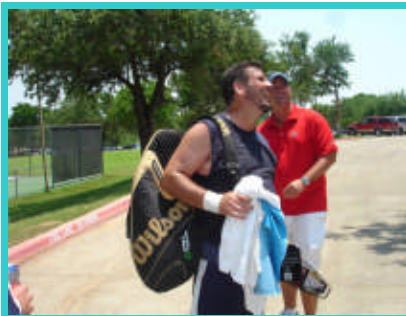

On the Greens

I would like to thank each one of you for remaining on the paths on the holes designated with signage and the green and white stakes. The benefit of the lack of cart traffic on these holes greatly improves the health of the roughs and the fairways on these holes. We will continue to rotate holes on a regular basis.

We have our second greens aerification scheduled for the 6th and 7th. We will do nine holes a day and keep nine holes open for play. Fairway aerification is schedule to begin the week of the 8th. It should take a week to ten days to complete this task. Fairway aerification is just as important as greens aerification as it provides the same benefits of relieving compaction and allowing oxygen to enter the soil profile. Between cart traffic and regular mowing the soil type on our fairways can become very compacted. Once completed the fairways should be healed in about ten to fourteen days. Your understanding during this process is greatly appreciated.

Red Light Green Light Monthly Golf Tip

Everyone knows what the traffic lights mean. Red means stop; Yellow means caution; and Green means go. A great golf course management strategy incorporates those images. Next time you are playing, instead of firing at every hole location, use the traffic lights to help you make better decisions. Let's say you are 175 yards away from the hole in the rough, and the hole is tucked behind a bunker. I would consider that a Red Light hole location. I would not play my shot toward the pin, I would play to the safest side of the green. Now let's say that the hole is right in the middle of the green and I am 100 yards away in the middle of the fairway. I would consider this a Green Light hole location and fire right at the pin. You can now imagine what a Yellow Light scenario might be. So the next time you are out on the golf course, try using this imagery for your course management strategy and how you choose to shoot at the hole locations. It will probably end up saving you at least a stroke or two.

Keep it in the fairway. Scott McClinton

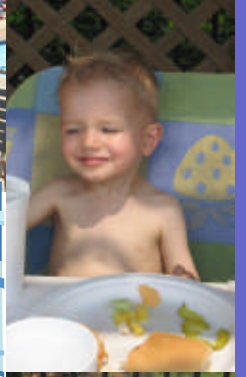

Eldorado 2010 Swim Team *THE SHARKS*

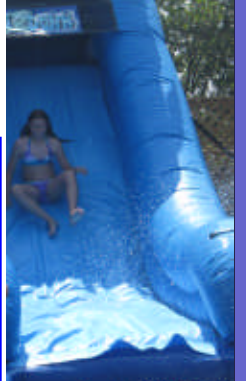

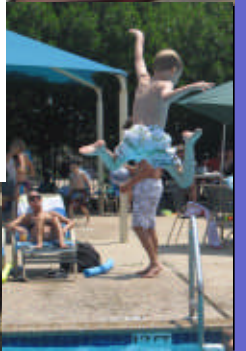
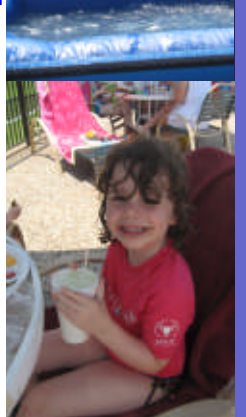

Hydration - How Much Water is Enough?

According to the Mayo Clinic Staff, water is your body's principal chemical component, making up, on average, 60 percent of your body weight. Every system in your body depends on water. For example, water flushes toxins out of vital organs, carries nutrients to your cells and provides a moist environment for ear, nose and throat tissues. Lack of water can lead to dehydration, a condition that occurs when you don't have enough water in your body to carry out normal functions. Even mild dehydration can drain your energy and make you tired.

How much water does an adult need? Every day you lose water through your breath, perspiration, urine and bowel movements. For your body to function properly, you must replenish its water supply by consuming beverages and foods that contain water. Several approaches attempt to approximate water needs for the average, healthy adult living in a temperate climate.

There are three primary water consumption estimates: Replacement Approach, Eight 8 –Ounce Glasses of Water Theory, and Dietary Guidelines. All recommendations point to approximately 2 to 3 liters of water and/or foods that contain water per day for an adult.

Factors that influence water needs? You may need to modify your total fluid intake depending on how active you are, the climate you live in (yes, with the hot Texas climate you will need to increase your water consumption during the summer), your health status, and if you're pregnant or breast-feeding.

Top Tips for Increasing Your Water Intake

- 1) Drink a glass of water first thing in the morning, since you've had no fluids for many hours.
- 2) Drink water constantly throughout the day and 16 ounces with each meal and snack.
- 3) If you have problems with constipation, it could be because you don't drink enough water—our
