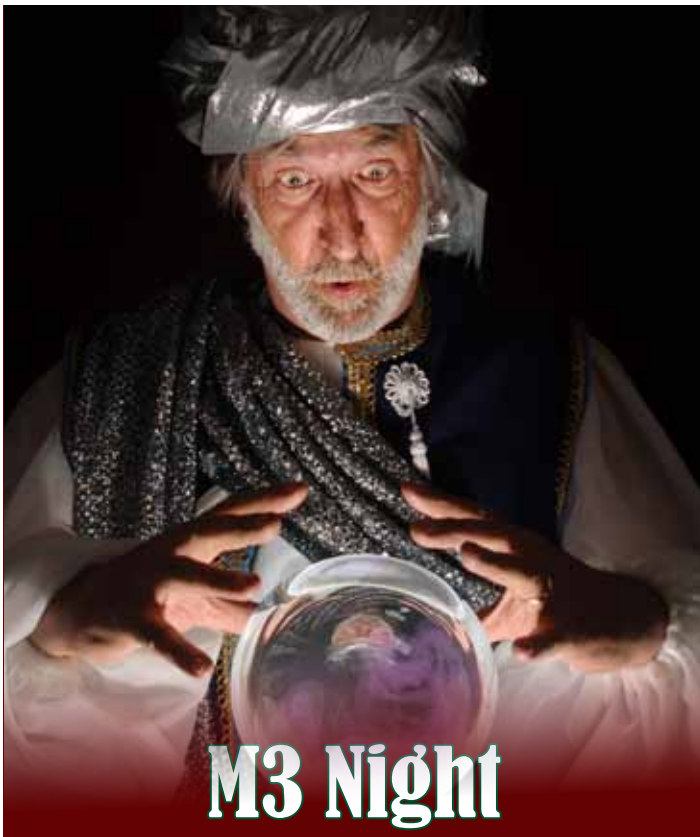

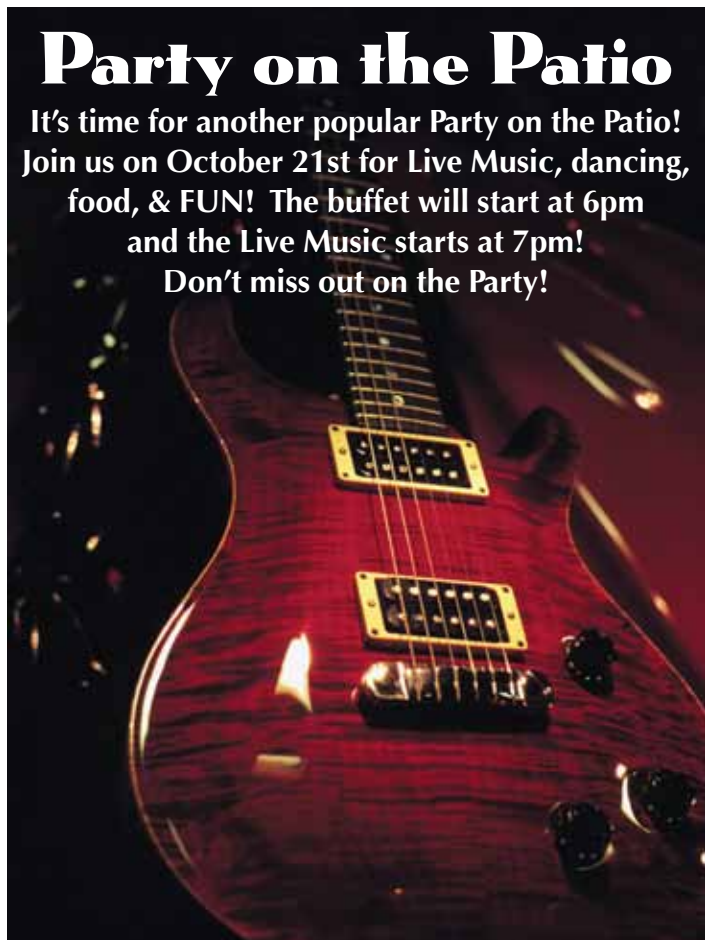


Kids Night Out

We will have instructors out from 4:30-6:30pm to help juniors prepare for NTPGA tournament golf and their High School Program.

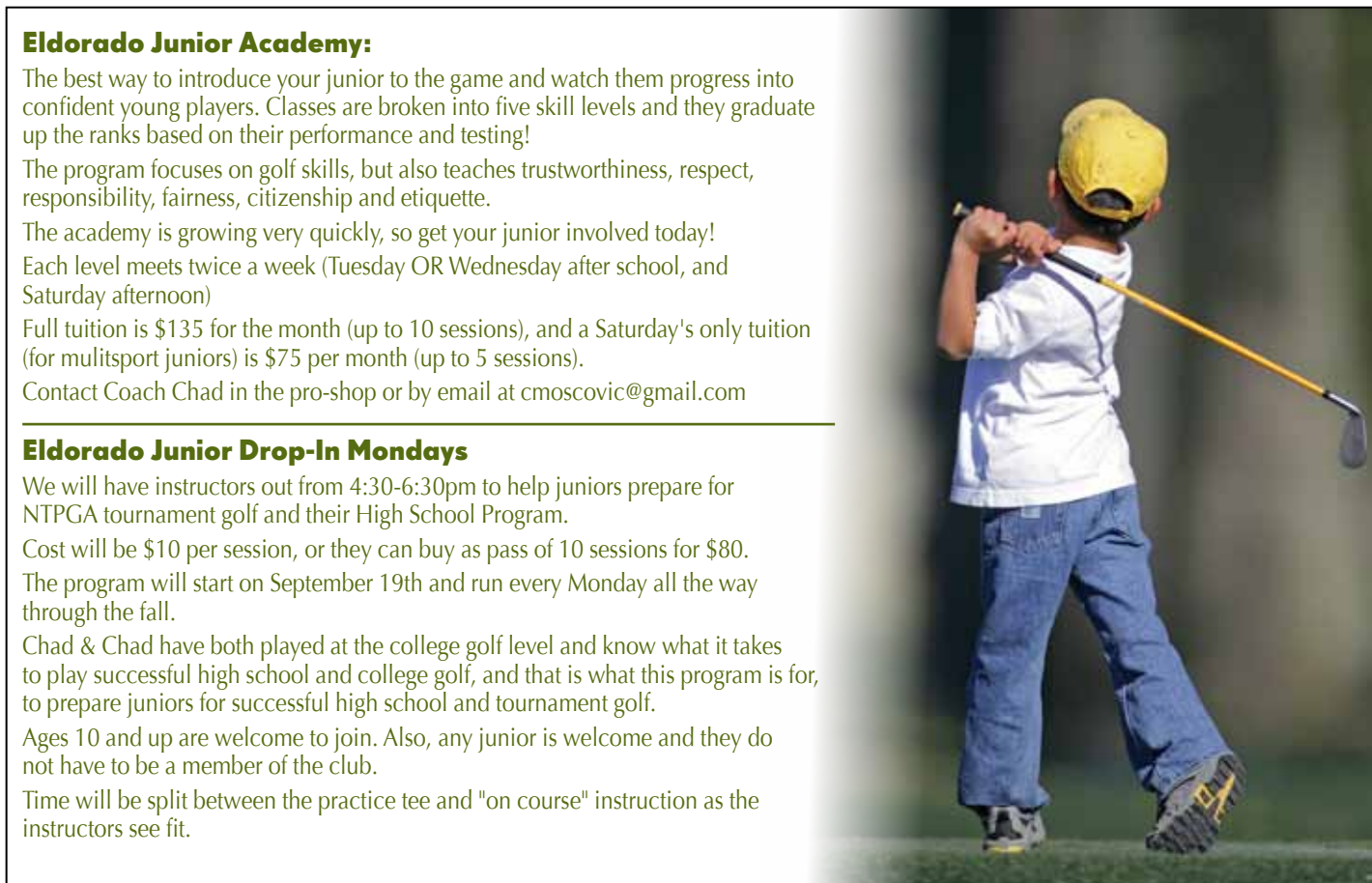
Cost will be \$10 per session, or they can buy a pass of 10 sessions for \$80.

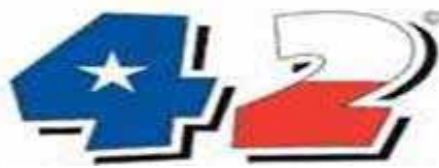

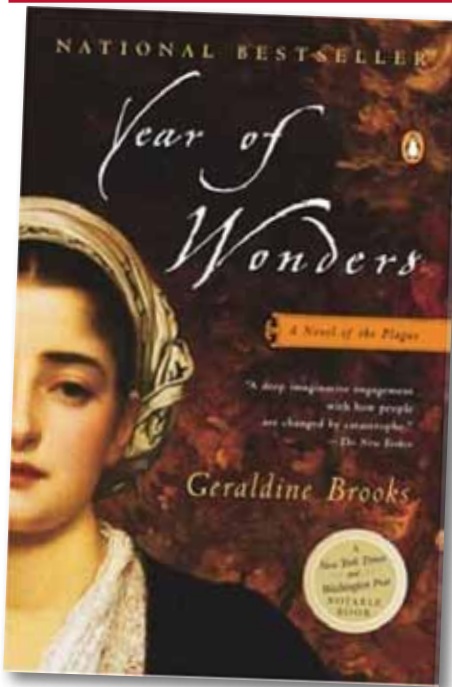
