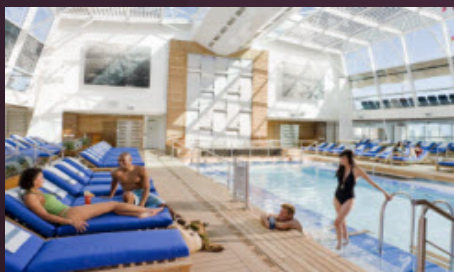

The project began with the construction of a permanent wall that separates the new expanded Sports Grill area from the Main Ball Room. After the wall is completed, the rest of the demolition and construction will resume on September 6th. After Labor Day Grill operations as we currently know it will end. We will only be able to serve on the Patio, Locker Rooms and some limited availability in the Hillcrest. We will post a monthly schedule of room availability as we progress through the project. We will make every attempt to provide you with as much food & beverage service as possible. The anticipated completion time needed is 60-75 days so we are looking at mid November. 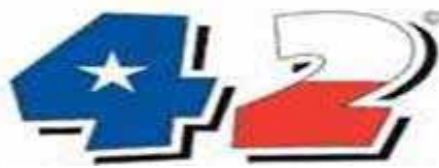

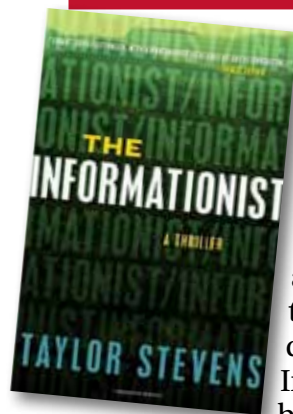
