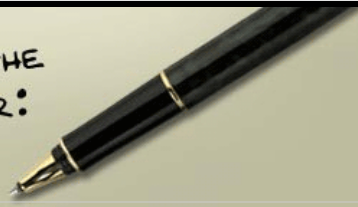

As we head into May we have our first core aeration scheduled to take place on the 6th. These aerifications are a very important cultural practice that helps us manage the thatch layer in our greens. Without managing the thatch our greens would become soft and spongy, susceptible to disease, and display inhibited drainage. We will be pulling a 3/8ths core and expect the time to heal to be about two weeks. Thank you in advance for your understanding during this process.
