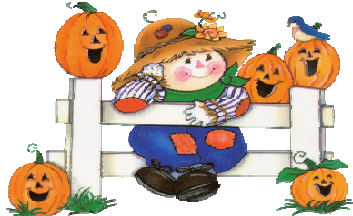

Since the beginning in 1997, The First Tee has reached over 9 million young golfers and non-golfers. As members of a private club, and lovers of the game of golf, The First Tee gives all of us an opportunity to introduce young people to the game that we all love.

The second charity that we support in the golf shop here at Eldorado is "Folds of Honor", and more specifically to golf, "Patriot Golf Day" in support of Folds of Honor. The mission of Folds of Honor is: *"We proudly stand in the gap, providing scholarships and assistance to the spouses and children of those killed or disabled in service to America"*

Every year on Labor Day weekend, we try to raise money to do our part to support this great cause. As a club full of veterans, ex-military, and family of military we strive to contribute thousands of dollars each year to this great cause.

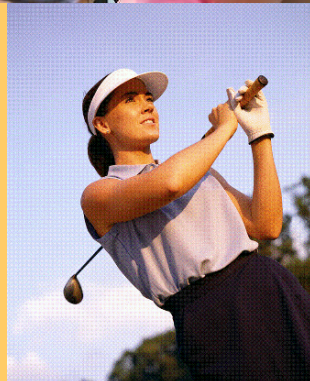

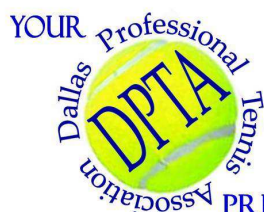




Hey TEAM ELDORADO,
