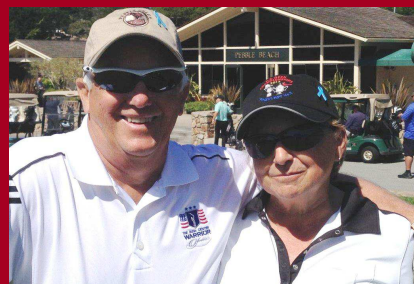

It is a time of the year to think about family and to be grateful for all the opportunities we have in this country. I hope you had time to vote for Board of Governor's candidates. ## A MESSAGE FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER:



Dear Members – I can't believe that over a month has already gone by since I arrived at Eldorado Country Club. I am finally out of the Extended Stay hotel, am partially unpacked in my new house in Allen and have successfully retrieved my pups from their

“vacation” in Austin. And now, of course, the holidays are upon us!

Although, I realize I have met many of you, there are still a majority of Members that I have still not come into contact with. I apologize for that and commit to you that you will continue to see me out and about the Club on a regular basis. I have had a ton of feedback in the past several weeks and would like to address the “Top Three” items that have come to my attention so far.

- Members Parking in the Fire Lane – I was surprised this was such a common topic, but this complaint came up to me on a fairly consistent basis. It turns out that I didn't even need to do anything about it. A few Members took it upon themselves to call the local police department and the parking lot is now being monitored on a fairly regular basis with tickets given to individuals who decide to illegally park in the fire lanes.
- Weekend Tee Times – we have been closely monitoring the weekend tee time availability and it appears that these are now being distributed fairly. I have made an extra effort to ensure that everyone is going through the call in system with no “automatic” tee times being scheduled. We will continue to monitor this, but I have had several folks tell me that they have seen a significant improvement in this process over the last several weeks.
- 18% F&B Item Charge – I have sent a separate letter on this subject that has gone out with all of the billing statements, but to summarize – we will be changing back to the monthly set amount service charge and eliminating the 18% on individual items with Member a la carte dining starting January 1, 2016. More so than either of the other two items above, this was – by far – the most contentious topic that came up in my first few weeks. After doing quite a bit of research, I determined that acquiescing to this requested change from the Membership would be in the best interest of all parties.

In other news, we have been working on several other projects in the last couple of months and have planning in place for several more. Please see the list below for just a handful of items.

- Athletics – Major repairs have been made on all of the equipment in the athletics area
- Grille – As I type this, I have just approved for all of the window treatments in the Grille to be replaced as most of the current ones are either broken or missing completely
- Sprinklers – While not a project that is very “exciting”, we have major problems with our current fire suppression system. We are making these repairs immediately before further issues arise possibly causing problems on a Club-wide basis
- The golf course maintenance department just acquired a new sprayer for the course
- I am putting together plans to address bunker renovations and, while I don't have any further information on this at this time, I will continue to work this project
- The new furniture for the Ladies Locker Room should be here by late December or early January
- The Club is exploring a project to address lighting across all areas
- We are looking at a new website provider to increase our current capabilities

Again – this is just a small taste of what we have been working on. More information will be communicated when made available. I look forward to 2016 at the Club and hope you all have a wonderful holiday season!

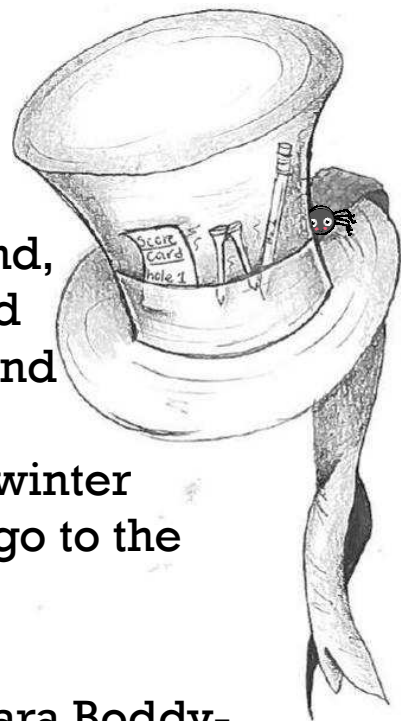
# EWGA Through the 2015 Looking Glass

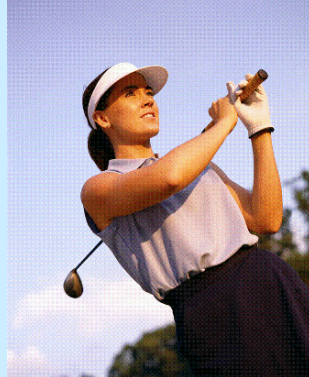

I would like to start by sharing some good news as we have finally received our last new piece of equipment this year. As a whole the golf course maintenance department received a new greens sprayer, a new trim mower, a new debris blower and three new utility carts. We would like to thank our new owners for this equipment and their commitment to giving us the tools we need.

As we head into December we will probably have already had our first frost of the season. Usually our first frost will affect the roughs and the fairways. It sometimes will be mid December before we have our first frost occur on the greens. It is when we have first on the greens that a delay in start times will occur. The reason for the delay is to protect the greens from damage that may occur from mechanical and foot traffic. The reason that damage can occur is because the leaf of the plant is frozen. When weight is applied the cell walls of the plant can be shattered because they consist mostly of water. One footprint is not that bad but when you consider that one foursome can leave up to one hundred footprints per green it can be rather devastating to the turf when it begins to actively grow again in the spring. So please bear with us when we have frost delays and we will get you out playing as soon as the turfs health is out of danger.

The golf course maintenance staff would also like to wish everyone a happy and safe holiday.

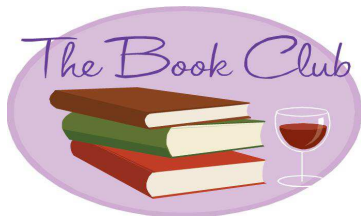

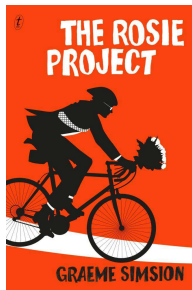

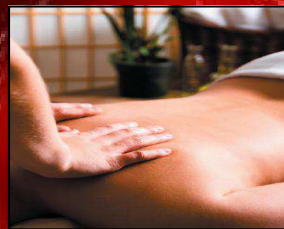
