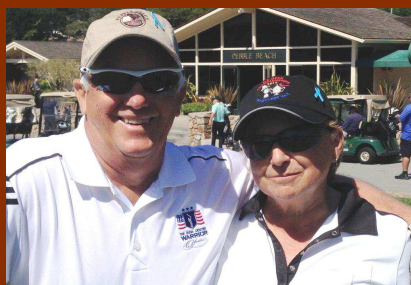

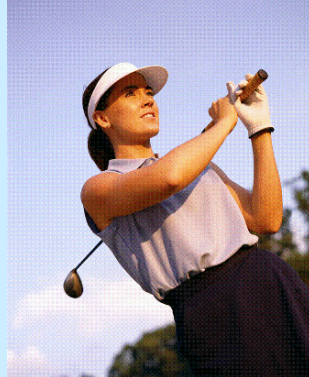
Powerball

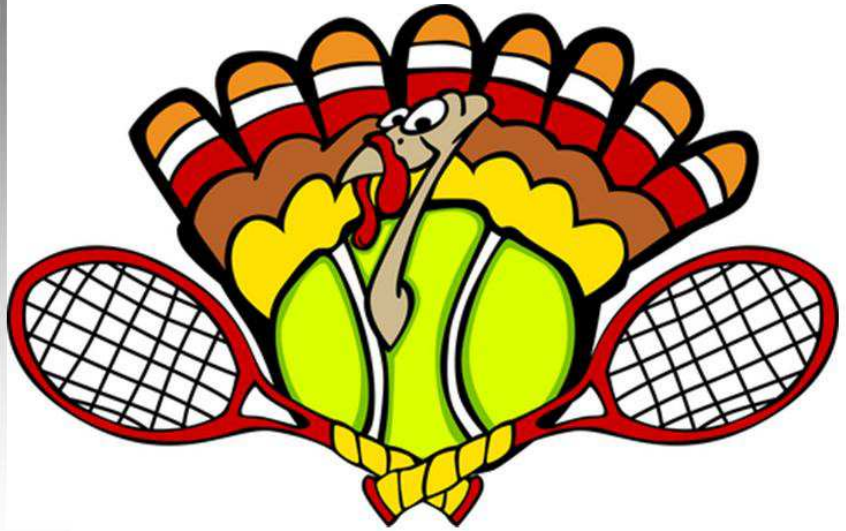

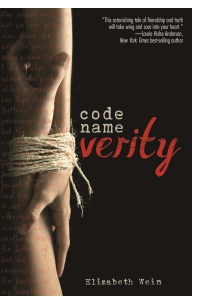
