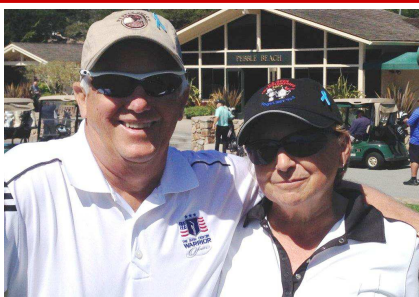

Welcome to the February edition of Calef's Corner. With the winter weather upon us it is important to grab hold of the occasional warm weather as it comes. Because of that you have probably noticed that the golf shop and golf course have opened on a couple Mondays that were unseasonably warm. These warm periods are the perfect time to break off a little winter rust on the golf clubs and come out to the course. It is especially a good time to stretch those muscles a bit and maybe even walk the course. If you haven't walked and played golf in awhile I urge you to try it. You will see that golf is truly a workout, and you may even notice that you are a little sore at the end of the round. This time of year a 60 degree day is a bonus day, and any chance to come out to the club, swing the sticks, and get some exercise is an opportunity you should jump at.



As far as the golf course goes, you will notice now that the entire course is pretty browned out. We have entered full dormant mode, and right now you will see that the ball bounces and rolls a lot more than it does in the Spring, Summer, and Fall. Try to keep that in mind when you are trying to lay up on the second hole, because that little ball will try its best to run right into that lake. Also when you are on the putting greens, keep in mind that there is no grain to stop the ball from rolling to the front of the greens. We all know how aggravating it is to have putts run by the hole and off the front of the green, but keep in mind that it is happening to everyone, and the difficult greens are one of the things that makes Eldorado one of the most challenging courses in the area. I promise you that you will be a better putter in the long run, and when you go and play at a friend's club you will find that putting will be that much easier and your game will be better for it.

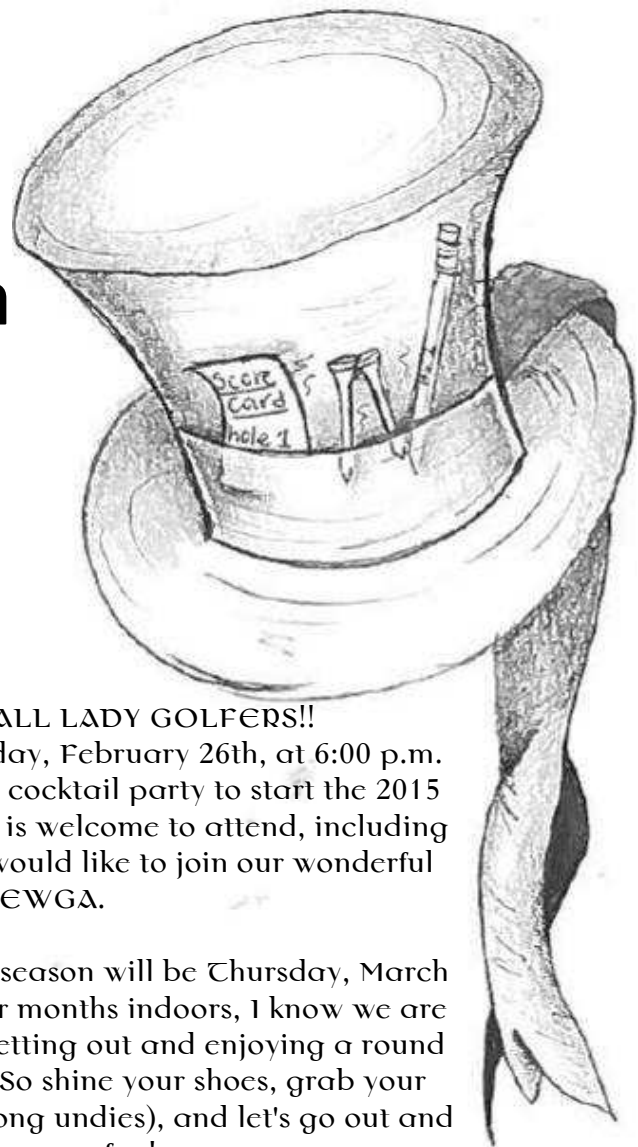

Ladies Golf Clinics

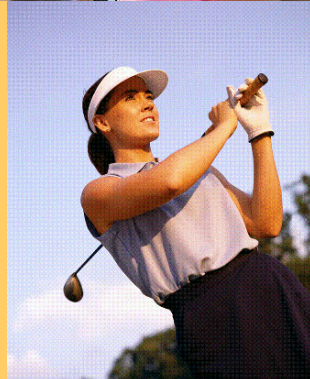

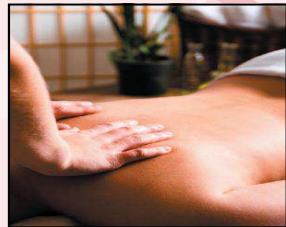

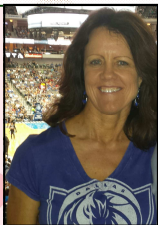

The month of February is shaping up to be a busy month for the Golf Course Maintenance department. We can only hope that the weather continues to be mild with plenty of good golfing days with some timely rains in between to help us recover from the drought conditions we are seeing across most of Texas.

During the month we will be spraying our preemergent herbicide for weed control through the spring and summer. It usually takes us two weeks to complete the application.

The major project that we are working on will be continuing to address the many irrigation leaks we have throughout the course. As our irrigation system continues to age and the ground continues to shrink and swell based off of soil moisture content, leaks will persist. We will address each as they arise. Thank you for your patience as we take care of them.
