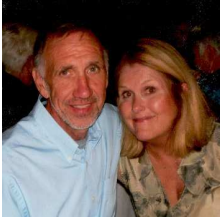
# Ambassador News...by Chris & Jill Heidorf

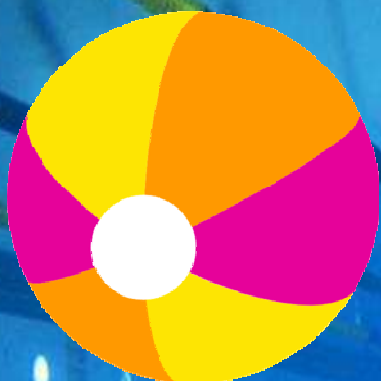

# Calef's Corner

Welcome to this month's edition of Calef's corner. Typically by this time of year we are well into our hot weather and the golf course is beginning to dry out and firm up. This year that is not the case. We have had record breaking rain over the last two months, and it has affected not just the local lakes and rivers, but our wonderful golf course as well. As I am sure that you have seen while out there playing, we have areas of the course that are lower than others and become extremely wet after heavy rains. What we ask is that you do your best to avoid these areas with golf carts, and when it is really bad and we are on cart paths only, we ask that you please keep all four wheels on the paths at all times. Just the act of passing another cart can cause ruts in the wet ground that will last the remainder of the season. Aaron and his crew do a great job of repairing damage to the course, but cart tracks across wet fairways when we are supposed to be staying on the paths affects everyone and scars the fairways for months.

As for your personal golf game, I am usually talking about drinking plenty of water and applying sunscreen in June, but this month let's talk about playing in tough conditions. Wet, windy, and muddy conditions make it very difficult to make solid contact and control your ball flight. It also makes the golf course play much more difficult than normal. During times of sloppy conditions, it is best to focus on solid contact. Keep your head down, swing a little smoother, and really focus on hitting the golf ball solid, and the rest will take care of itself. If you have a particularly bad lie in the tall grass, or in an area that is muddy, try playing the ball further back in your stance an inch or two. By moving your ball position back you ensure that you are hitting the ball on a descending angle. Hitting down on the ball and hitting the golf ball before making your divot is the best way to make a pure strike, and solid contact has a tendency to cut through the wind and fly straighter, which is something that we all need!

June is also a great month for tournaments at Eldorado. Our MGA Member/Member, our ladies Member/Guest, and our SMGA Patriot Day all happen in June. We also have our Father/Junior event on Father's Day afternoon. Grab whichever child you like the most and come out to have some fun. OK, I'm joking, all children with their fathers are welcome on Father's Day, so come out and have a great time! As always, Thank you for Being a Member!

# EWGA Through the Looking GLASS

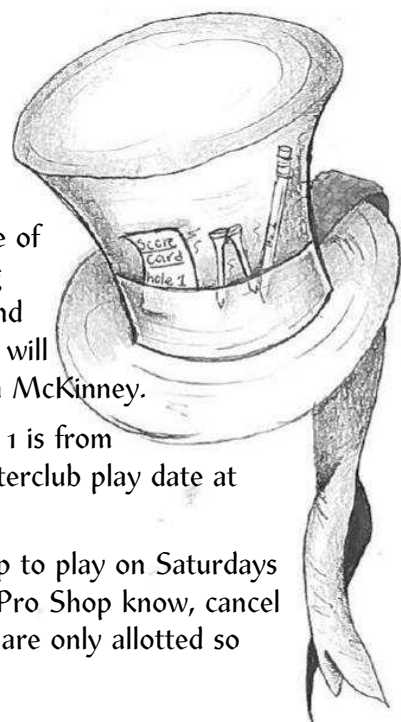

### **Ladies Golf Clinics**

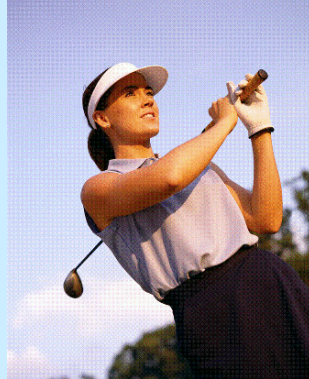

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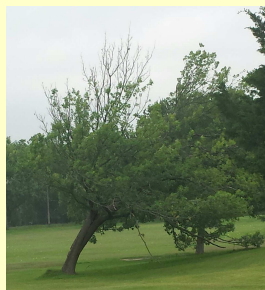
## Golf Course Talk
