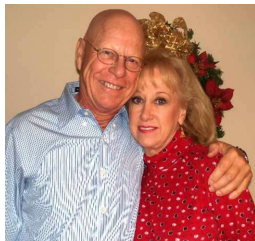
Ambassador News...by Chris & Jill Heidorf

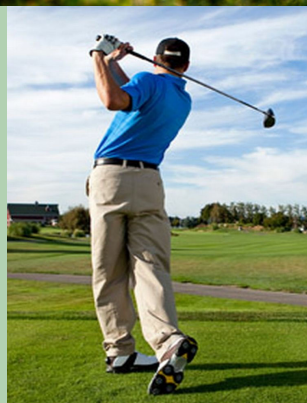
Powerball

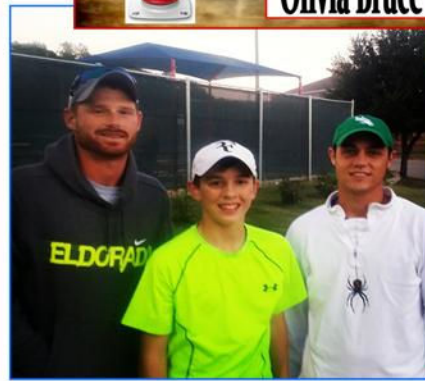

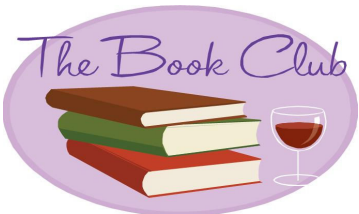

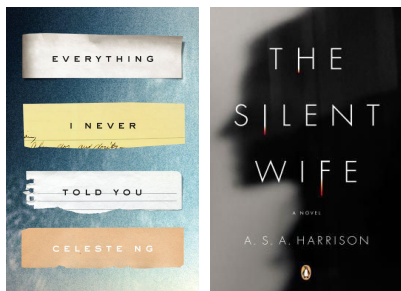
Spring Is Springing???
