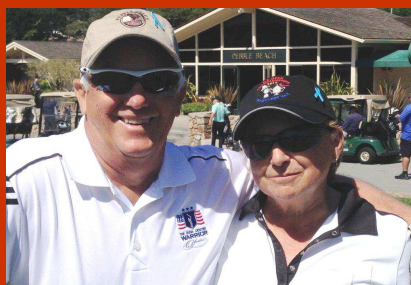

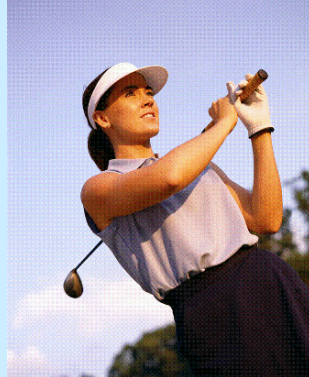
Powerball
