Board of Governor News...by Ron Harper

Well – we've made it through January. Another few weeks and the weather will be getting warmer and the days will be getting longer. Hopefully we will be getting some dryer weather so that the golf course will be more playable.

There are many opportunities for being involved at the club. We have a number of “clubs within the club” activities, and if we do not have one that interests you, contact Amber and she will help set it up. Kudos to Chef Chris for his Kid's Cooking Class. I heard it was fun for all (and a bit messy).



A MESSAGE FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER:



As I write this, McKinney is experiencing Spring-like weather. With temperatures in the mid 70's and not a rain drop in sight, we have even decided to take advantage of the unseasonably excellent conditions to open this Monday. We decided that there will be plenty of days in the next couple of months where golf will be next to impossible so why not open on a day where it will be gorgeous!!

Speaking of golf, I have had several meetings with our Head Pro, Jason Dawber, and our Golf Course Superintendent, Aaron Schick. Our main desire is to carefully consider the golf course maintenance policies to ensure that we are finding a balance between protecting the integrity of the golf course conditions along with maximizing the Member's ability to play at their home course. With unprecedented rain over the last year, we have dealt with several issues that have effected this balance. In particular, we have had to close down or limit playability on holes 12, 13 and 14 for an extended amount of time. This is, obviously, not our preference but has become necessary given the wet conditions. We will continue to keep a close eye on this area to make sure that we are achieving the right balance between playability and accessibility.

Another topic from a golf course perspective is a methodology to handle our turf transition as we come out of the Winter and into the Spring. Limiting excess turf traffic during the time period of transition will go a LONG way to improving the overall health of the turf for the entire year. For that reason, we have developed a "fairway closure rotation" to help with the overall long term turf health. Below I have outlined our plan for this procedure during the months of March and April. We feel that this no cost procedure will be extremely helpful in providing you with the best experience possible for the entire year.

- Par 3's on the Course will remain cart path only 100% of the time. These holes include # 5, 7 and 16.
- Several holes have features that should not require any closing (weather permitting) throughout the transition period. These holes include # 1, 2, 6, 10 and 11. We will explore the feasibility of setting up a rotating set of "entrances and exits" on these holes to help prevent wear patterns.
- With the exclusion of the holes above, this means that 10 holes are adversely impacted enough during the transition months due to carts on the fairways that we should implement a rotation system. These holes include # 3, 4, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17 and 18.
- Proposed Plan:
 - o Holes 3, 13 and 18 are closed to carts on the fairway from March 8 – March 21.
 - o Holes 4, 9 and 14 are closed to carts on the fairway from March 22 – April 4.
 - o Holes 8, 12 and 15 are closed to carts on the fairway from April 5 – April 18.
 - o Hole 17 is closed to carts on the fairway from April 19 – May 2.
 - o After May 2, all holes (except Par 3's) will be available for cart use on the fairway unless weather or turf condition dictates otherwise.
 - o In 2017, hole rotation will start again in early March with adjustments made given the first year of experience
- The above dates can be adjusted based on status of our winter to spring transition.
- Hole 17 is scheduled extra by itself as we know that hole is most at risk to accumulate additional damage due to fairway width.

On another subject, March is the typical timeframe that Eldorado implements their annual dues increase. Accordingly, on March 1 there will be a 4% dues increase applied to all categories of Membership. To help offset this increase, I am happy to announce that we will once again be offering the ability to pay for your dues in advance. Anyone that wishes to take advantage of this will receive a \$300 credit as a Golf Member or a \$150 credit as a Social Member. In addition, anyone who chooses to pay via cash or check will receive an additional 2% discount. By utilizing this opportunity, you will have not only completely offset the annual dues increase, but you actually end up paying LESS in 2016 than 2015. Information regarding enrollment in this process will be sent with the February 1 billing statements.

Finally, I would like to thank everyone for your positive feedback about the recent Food & Beverage changes. Our servers have felt more appreciated with additional tip revenue in their weekly checks which I sincerely hope is translating into better service during your visits to the Club. We have already roughed out event plans all the way through the 2nd Quarter. I hope you are all looking forward to additional cooking classes, Murder Mystery, Wine events, kids events and other surprises along the way. We are even looking at having Chef Chris conduct an ice carving demonstration as a fun, educational twist that utilizes one of the many skill sets of our valued employees. Thank you so much for your support and your loyalty.

As an El Nino weather pattern in the Pacific continues to dictate our weather we have experienced a very wet but mild winter to date. The amount of rainfall since Thanksgiving is approaching twenty five inches. The ground is completely saturated and the water has no where else to go. Holes 12, 13 and 14 have flooded many times and we have had to endure some hole closures and play the holes modified.

As the golf course maintenance staff has spent many man hours cleaning up after each event we are behind on some of our normal winter activities such as leaf cleanup, ball washer refurbish and tee marker painting. We are working diligently to get caught up and hope to be back on regular schedule soon.

During the month we will be spraying our preemergent herbicide for weed control through the spring and summer. It usually takes us two weeks to complete the application.

We will be continuing to address the many irrigation leaks we have throughout the course. As our irrigation system continues to age and the ground continues to shrink and swell base off of soil moisture content leaks will persist. We will address each as they arise.

Thank you for your patience as we take care of them.

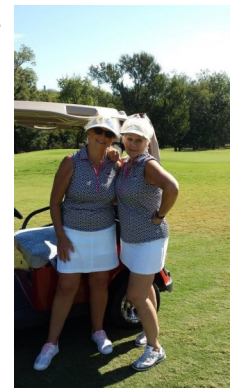
ATTENTION ALL LADY GOLFERS FOR EWGA 2016!!!

Think spring and see you on the course!

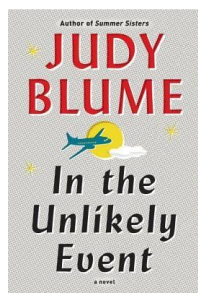
