On The Greens With Paul

We are in the beginning phase of construction on hole # 13. This project will consist of moving the tee box over to the north about 30 feet. We are also going to have to relocate the cart path, re-route our 12' main line, and move around some sprinkler heads in order to keep everything away from the new emergency spillway that is going to be built by the NRCS. We will probably have to play this hole as a par 3 until construction is completed. We are also going to be installing a new pump station toward the end of the month. Our portion of the work will take about a month to complete. The rest of the dam restoration project, which is being funded by the city and the NRCS, should begin this fall.

The dam restoration project will consist of rehabbing the dam that surrounds the lake on #12, increasing the size of the emergency spillway that is located just to the right of #12 green, and increasing the outfall pipe that is currently located on the east side of the lake from around 12' to 72'. This means that less flooding should occur on hole #12 and when it does flood, it should recede much quicker than it currently does allowing us to open hole 12 much sooner after a flood. In order to do this project, the lake on #12 will be drained for around 6 months. There are plans to dredge this lake in the future, however, it does not seem that it will coincide with this project. The timeline of this project is estimated around one year to complete.
