On The Greens with Paul Hagy

Not much going on this time of year. We are in the process of our winter weed control by dormant spraying our fairways and roughs with Roundup and Simazine. The Simazine has pre and post emergent capabilities which will not only kill the weeds that have popped up but also keep new ones from popping up until our spring pre emergent application.

We have had to put the greens covers on a few times when we have had a couple of hard freezes. This is just added insurance that the sub-freezing temperatures will not harm the Champion bermudagrass and it breaks dormancy in the spring with no problems.

I hope everyone had a happy holiday season and we are looking forward to another great year!
