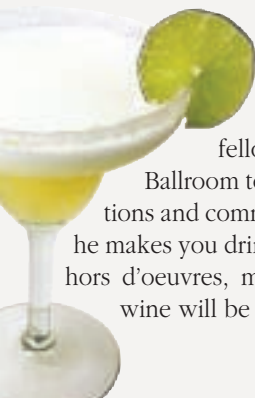

Handicap Committee Update

In response to questions received from the membership, your Handicap Committee would like to remind you of the basic principles of the *USGA Handicap System*.

The guiding principles are best stated in the following paragraphs from *The USGA Handicap System* manual:

"The purpose of the *USGA Handicap System* is to make the game of golf more enjoyable by enabling players of differing abilities to compete on an equitable basis. The System provides a fair *Course Handicap* for each player, regardless of ability, and adjusts a player's *Handicap Index* up or down as the player's game changes. At the same time, the System disregards high scores that bear little relation to the player's potential ability and promotes continuity by making a *Handicap Index* continuous from one playing season or year to the next. A *Handicap Index* is useful for all forms of play, and is issued only to individuals who are members of a *golf club*."

"Two basic premises underlie the *USGA Handicap System*, namely that each player will try to make the best score at every hole in every round, regardless of where the round is played, and that the player will post every acceptable round for *peer review*. The player and the player's *Handicap Committee* have joint responsibility for adhering to these premises."

The wonderful thing about *The USGA Handicap System* is that whether you are a skilled low-handicapper or a weekend 'duffer' you can have a competitive match with any other golfer – even a touring pro. Our tennis playing friends are not so lucky.

We know everyone tries to make the best score on every hole, let's address the question about posting scores. We are lucky enough to live in an area where golf can be played year-round – therefore, scores must be posted year-round. If you complete 13 holes (7 holes for a 9-hole score) that score must be posted. Also, scores for both stroke play and match play are to be posted.

Tip for the month: Spring time has many days where the dew and moisture in the air is more prevalent in the early morning. This causes the ball to be heavier than in the later hours when the sun has burned off that moisture. This heavy ball often causes ground strokes to land short in the court. Make sure to aim deeper and use a longer stroke so that your opponents can not attack these short balls. As the

sun gets stronger the ball will travel more easily so you can pull back on this stroke later in the day.
