

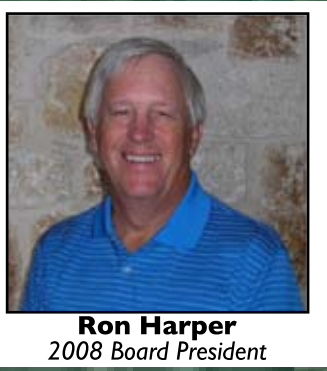

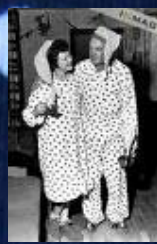

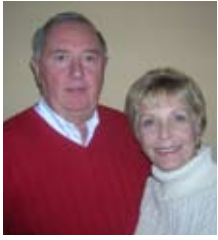


AMBASSADORS NEWS

Gossip from the Grill

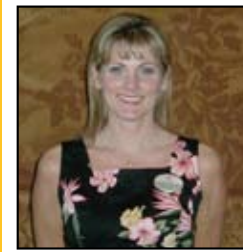

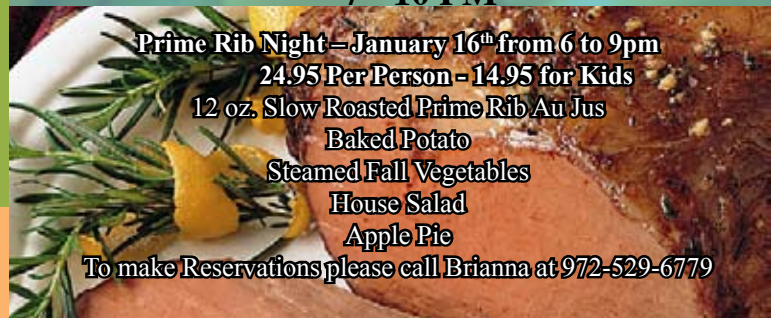
