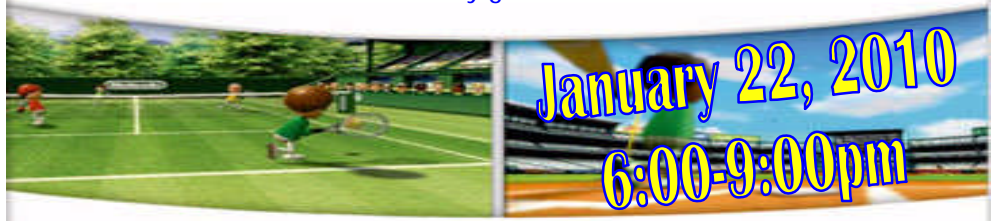

Club Rules & Etiquette To Remember:

It's the off season and I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the clubs rules and etiquette standards that you have set forth the golf staff to uphold.

Organization of the Month ~ By The Saturday Golf Guys

Not many folks at Eldorado Country Club are aware of a certain group of Saturday golfers. Tee times are usually near 9:00 AM for the group. Overall the group consists of 28 golfers. Emails are sent to each group member on Monday morning. Each person responds to whether or not they are playing the following Saturday. Then tee times are secured on Wednesday morning. Typically 15 to 20 of the group commit to play on any given Saturday.

Approximately 5 years ago the group was talking about how fortunate we were to be able to play golf. Then came an idea. How about collecting money from each member during the course of the year? In early December we would vote on charities that we wish to contribute to. Everyone agreed this was a great idea.

Since that original concept everyone in the group looks forward to giving to charities. It was also agreed that all contributions should stay in McKinney.

Our process is simple. Each month each member contributes a designated amount. The group has a treasurer, and if a member is not current in paying their contribution the treasurer makes sure (non-violent) that the delinquent member brings himself up-to-date.

Two years ago we also added an extra collection at the end of each quarter. This was to take care of our own members. Flowers, plants, and gift baskets are sent to a group member who may have had surgery or a death in the family.

Over the past five years The Saturday Golf Guys have donated \$14,450 to local charities. Some of these charities include, The Samaritan Inn, Children's and Community Health Clinic, CASA, Serenity High School, The Boys and Girls Club of Collin County-McKinney Branch, Salvation Army Angel Tree, Hopes Door, and The Turning Point. The group has also provided funds for a paralyzed young man (from the neck down) with two young children so they could have Christmas presents.

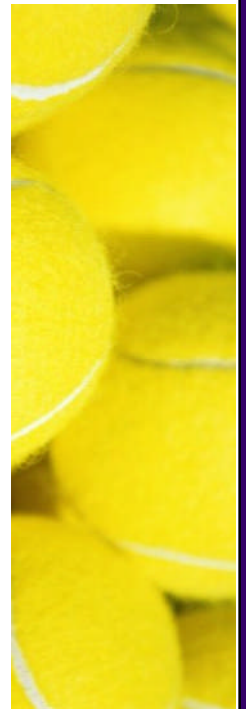
