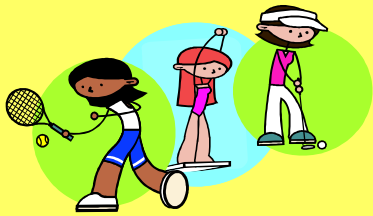

# Message From The Manager

Eldorado Lake Sediment Removal Project Update

As previously mentioned, the City of McKinney project to remove sediment from the lake on #12 and the upper lakes along #15, #16, and #17 has been halted due to the contractor, Turner Environmental Inc., abandoning the project. The city of McKinney bonded the work under Travelers Insurance. Travelers Insurance is finishing the project evaluation now and should soon have a bid out to finish the sediment removal.

I am in constant communication with the city on the status of the project and to insure the project gets completed as agreed upon. The city believes the project should get started again by July 4<sup>th</sup> with a one to three month timeframe on the job. The city apologizes for the situation and is working hard to get the job completed as fast as possible.

Another ongoing project is the hand sink water issue with the bathroom on #15 tee box. Last year the hand sinks in the restrooms were disconnected due to not having potable water in that location. We have been working with the city and a contractor to find a way to tap into city water for that location. At the current time, we have not found a solution and we are working with another contractor to find a way to treat the current water. In the meantime, both golf course restrooms will be going through a makeover to improve the appearance.

# On The Greens With Aaron

I would like to thank each one of you for remaining on the paths on the holes designated with signage and the green and white stakes. The benefit of the lack of cart traffic on these holes greatly improves the health of the roughs and the fairways. We will continue to rotate holes on a regular basis.

Fairway aerification is schedule to begin the week of the 22<sup>nd</sup>. It should take the majority of the week to complete this task. Fairway aerification is just as important as greens aerification as it provides the same benefits of relieving compaction and allowing oxygen to enter the soil profile. Between cart traffic and regular mowing the soil type on our fairways can become very compacted. Once completed the fairways should be healed in about ten to fourteen days. Your understanding during this process is greatly appreciated.

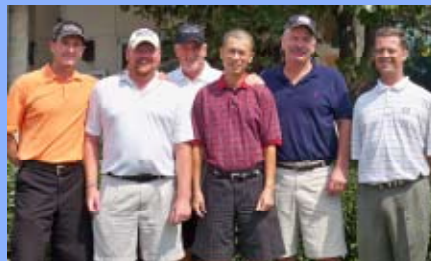
