Right now we believe it is 525 golfing memberships.

How do we get there?

From referrals from our existing members.

Who should I consider as a referral?

Someone who you think would enjoy many or all of the benefits of membership at ECC. It could be a neighbor, or friend, or co-worker, or someone you volunteer with, or a customer or client, or even someone you happen to meet and think would fit in. If you see that a new family has moved into your neighborhood, go over and say "Hello and Welcome" then find out if they might be a candidate.

How do I make a referral?

If you happen to be in the Clubhouse, look for one of the gold boxes and fill out the referral form you will find there; or call Chelsea or Colleen or Donny, or drop any of them an E-mail.

What will happen to my referral?

Chelsea will contact the person as soon as she can and extend an invitation to them to come to the club for a tour, a meal and, if they are golfers, a round of golf. She will arrange for one of the members of the Ambassadors' Club to assist with the tour and to play golf or tennis with the prospect. If the prospect is interested in joining our club and if they fit in, they will be extended a formal written invitation to become a member and, if you referred them, you will be listed as their sponsor. You don't have to do anything but give us a name and phone number or address, we will do the rest and they will be impressed.

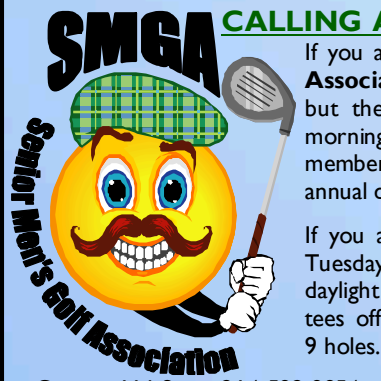

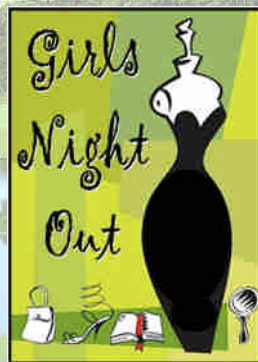
