# GOLF NEWS

## ON THE GREENS WITH PAUL

Wow, another year has come and is almost gone! At the end of the year, I always like to look back and evaluate what we accomplished during the year just to remind myself and everyone else how we are moving forward on the golf course and come up with some items to accomplish during the next year.

The first thing we accomplished was the removal of the railroad tie bulkhead surrounding the pond on #2 and installing a stone faced wall that has dramatically increased the aesthetics of that hole. The pond was dredged out and is now about 20 feet deep instead of 3 feet.

The tee boxes on #13 were moved over to the north in order to accommodate the dam project that was underway on #12. In my opinion, this gave the tee shot a better angle to the fairway. Although, we didn't do the work, how about # 12 fairway not flooding a single time during all the rain we received this year. Wow! Had that spillway not been completed we might have had the back nine closed for a couple of months. We should all definitely thank the city and the NRCS for getting this done and hopefully they can finish the project by dredging all of the lakes.

Cart path extensions were put in on several holes where the cart paths were just too narrow and carts and equipment could not stay on them. Curbing was put in on a few holes to keep carts from parking next to greens and to allow the turf to grow. The biggest impact of this was on hole # 4 green where rain had eroded much of the soil around the cart path leaving ruts and exposed soil with no grass. Now, it is fully grassed and carts cannot park on the grass because of the curb.

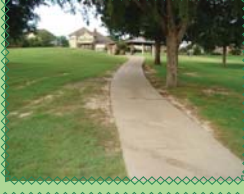
The front nine bunkers were renovated using cap fund money and what a difference they make. Liners were installed, new drainage was added and new sand was put in to replace the old stuff. In October we were able to complete the bunker project by renovating the back nine bunkers. Therein lies the importance of your referrals, so we can get money to complete the project and to also begin other projects. Without member cap fund dollars, these projects would NOT take place and we do not want to stop here.

Again, I know I belabor this point, but the tree work that we have done on this golf course has made a dramatic improvement to the health of the rough and some of the fairways. The rough has more grass than it has had since I have been here and we must continue to prune and remove certain trees to keep moving in the right direction. I remember the PGA tournament at Oakmont Country Club this year and they said they had removed something like 2500 trees. No need for us to get that aggressive, but we must continue to do what we are doing. Before the armyworms attacked our fescue, we had more fescue under the trees than we have ever had but we will re-seed those areas again this year and get this re-established.

Finally, the project that could be the most important one of all is the installation of a new pump station. Water is the lifeblood of a golf course and we limped through several years of pumps going out in the middle of the summer. This is not something that you might think makes a difference like a sand trap or cart path but without a doubt will increase the health of the turf that you play on. It may not be something that you physically see transform overnight but knowing that the golf course will water every time will make me sleep better at night.

To me, this is a pretty impressive list considering the fact that we received record rainfall and lost a couple of months due to wet conditions. It is my intention to keep moving forward with capital improvement projects but I can't reiterate how important your member referrals are to this process. Quite frankly, without your referrals and us adding new members, the cap fund will not increase and the projects that we would like to continue to do will not happen. This is a win-win situation for everyone involved, the club stays strong by adding new members and the capital improvement projects continue to enhance not only the golf course but the club overall.
