Fitness for Youth and Teens

Classes will be held the 2nd Saturday of each month from 11:00-12:00**

Many of us have children that are either involved in sports and would like to use the fitness facility to train during the offseason or just like to use the equipment available for exercising. With the growing concern of childhood obesity in our nation we would like to offer a solution to our fitness area age limit that provides a safe environment for everyone. **The following policy will start in January of 2009.**

Fitness Age Policy

For the safety of our children we have decided to limit the fitness area to adults and children over 16 year of age. If you have children between the ages of 10-15 that would like to use the fitness equipment they **must attend a Youth & Teen Fitness Class before fitness facility privileges are granted.**

The class focuses on proper technique, safety, and etiquette in the weight/cardio room as well as in the group exercise room. After taking the class children 10-15 years old may use the fitness facility without immediate parent supervision.

Please note that if your child does not take the class you can not have them in either fitness area even if you are supervising them.
