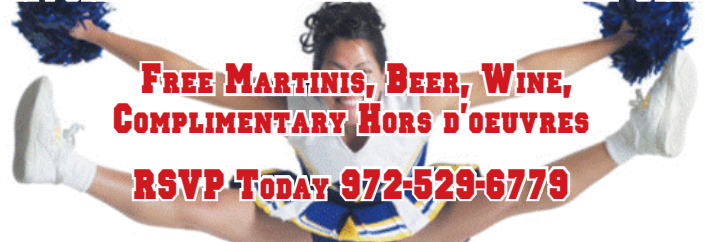

On The Greens With Paul Hagy

Wow! Hopefully September will bring us a break from the August heat. Early morning watering and afternoon sprinkler repair has kept us busy in the blistering August heat wave. We also cancelled August's aerification due to the extreme heat. We will resume with our September 8 aerification.

Overall, the course has held up pretty well. Wouldn't you know it, on the hottest day of the year one of our irrigation controllers went out and left # 5 green without water for a couple of days. The temperature was 107 degrees that day and it only takes one night without the regular irrigation cycle in that kind of heat to cause problems. We have since fixed the controller and the green is recovering.

It is pre-emergent time again so we have already begun slinging fertilizer coated with a pre-emergent herbicide on the entire golf course to minimize the winter weeds. Amazingly, fertilizer prices have risen to double and triple of what they were last year. We have had to change the analysis a little bit in order to keep the cost down as much as possible and still pre-emerge wall to wall. This year we will be using a 0-0-22 analysis coated with Prodiamine. This will give us one lb of Active ingredient Acre (Prodiamine) and also just over one lb of Potassium to allow the plant to protect itself from winter damage. Please note that this means we are not cutting back on the amount of pre-emergent, we are simply changing the analysis of the fertilizer that we normally use. Last year we used a 5-5-20 analysis compared to this year's 0-0-22. Less Nitrogen and Phosphorous will help us keep the cost manageable without losing effectiveness of the pre-emergent.

Let's hope September brings us great football and cooler temperatures.

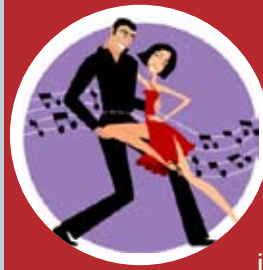
