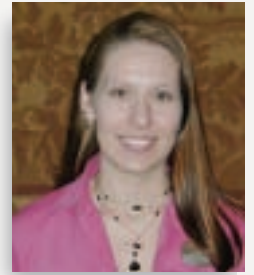

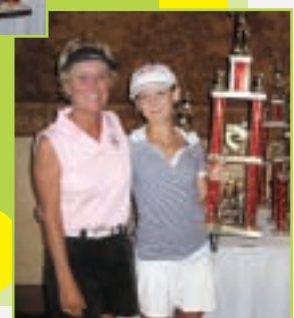

Summer is winding down and we have begun our fall pre-emergent applications, the greens have been aerified for the last time. We have had an outstanding year so far on the golf course and with the cooler weather we will begin prepping our fescue areas and overseeding some areas with ryegrass.

The fairway sprinkler head leveling project went well and is over. All of the sprinklers have been leveled and 40 sprinklers have been replaced with new ones. The plan is to replace 40-50 heads a year until all fairway heads have been replaced. There is a total of about 200 heads. New yardage markers have been ordered for these heads and will replace the temporary markers so they will all match.



Finally, if you get a chance, please welcome the new members from McKinney Country Club. They are all wonderful people and we are glad to have them here. Let's keep the referrals coming so we can make some major improvements to the club.

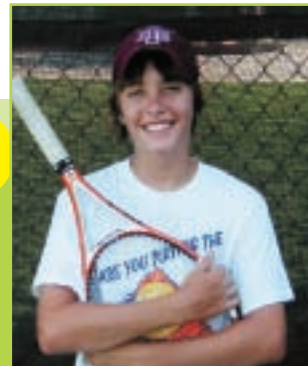

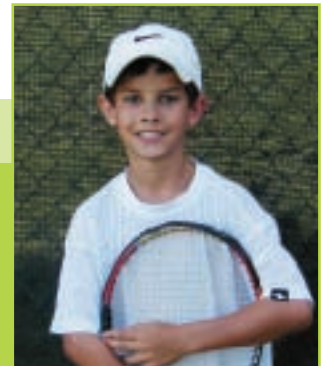
