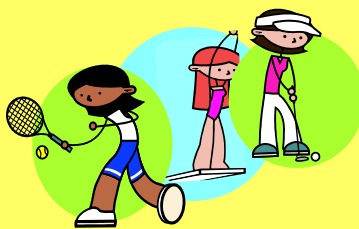

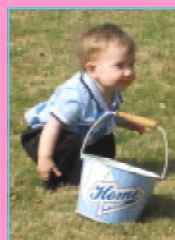

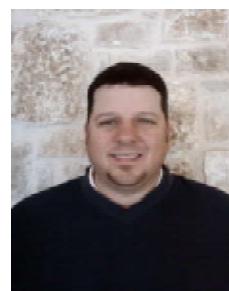

# Strokes

Perhaps too little known is the fact that we have a Handicap Committee at Eldorado Country Club whose function, *on behalf of the membership*, is to preserve and enhance the validity and accuracy of our handicapping system. No small group of individuals can effectively accomplish this task without the support and involvement of the membership. The membership must be its own policing force, just as the game of golf is essentially self-regulated. When suspected offenses in scoring accuracy or selective reporting do occur, members should pass their observations and concerns to a member of the Handicap Committee listed below. Any action taken will be based upon factual criteria such as from a multiple witness occurrence or from reports available through the GHIN system specifically designed to identify abnormalities. Each and every referred concern will be addressed and handled with discretion.

Although golf in Texas is a year-round sport, about this time each year the golfing activity level begins to increase as the weather improves. Each month through this "golfing season" the ECC Handicap Committee will produce a brief informational note, called "Strokes", in support of the spirit of competitive golf at Eldorado Country Club. For instance, have you noticed that we now have new scorecards. They look different (vertical vs. horizontal, a space for member #, etc.) and now reflect the revised ratings/slope and hole handicaps, including those for the Player's courses for both men and women.

Each round played, whether just 9 or a full 18 holes, regardless of match play format, score or where played, must be turned in and recorded on the GHIN system. If you don't wish to enter them yourself, you may turn them in to the Pro Shop staff. It isn't just the "sandbaggers" that hurt competition. You can do so with cash or add it to your bill.

Finally, the \$22.00 is also used to help pay for the coffee, tea and other snacks that are offered free of charge at certain times in the Grill.
